CONDITIONS

- 1 ELIGIBILITY** Open to swimmers who are registered Swim England Club Train (fitness swimmers) and Club Compete (competitive swimmers) members of Hampshire ASA clubs only.
- 2 AGE GROUPS** Masters 18 to 24, 25 to 29 and upwards in 5 year age bands to accommodate all entrants. Relay cumulative ages: 72+, 120 to 199 & 200+. Ages are as at **31st December 2023**. All swimmers must be 18 years of age or over **on 24th June 2023**.
- 3 RELAY TEAMS** Relay events are 4 x 50m mixed, (2 women and 2 men swimming in any order). Relays may be entered by completing the [google form](#) and paying the appropriate fee. A team declaration form must be completed on the day and handed into the control room. Once entries have closed a relay team may not change to a different age group.
- 4 REPRESENTATION** A competitor may only compete for one club in the competition.
- 5 ENTRIES** Entries will be on-line only. Entrants should check that they have entered the events intended and submitted times are correct. Once all entries have been processed a copy of the entries will be available on MeetMobile and will be made available to all entrants. See item 7 for how to pay entry fees.

Clubs may submit a bulk entry via the portal if they would prefer.
- 6 CLOSING DATES** Individual entries close at midday on **Monday 19th June 2023**. Entries may be closed earlier if the meet becomes fully subscribed before these dates. Late entries will not be accepted after the respective closing dates.
- 7 ENTRY FEES** All individual events £7.00 and team events £12.00. Swimmers that withdraw after the closing date will forfeit their entry fee. There will be a non-refundable administration charge of £2.00 for each individual and relay team entry regardless of how many events are entered. If the meet is cancelled for any reason all entry fees will be refunded. The promoter takes no responsibility for any consequential costs.

- 8 SEEDING** Events will be seeded in order of entry time, irrespective of age, from slowest to fastest. Swimmers with the slowest entry times will swim in the first heats. A no-time entry will not be accepted.
- 9 WITHDRAWALS** Prior to the closing date you may withdraw your entry using the entry portal.

After the closing date you may withdraw by completing the online form (details will be may available when entries lists are circulated). On the day you may withdraw by contact the tech team (details will be circulated in due course). We encourage withdrawals to be circulated as early as possible as this will avoid the risk of having empty lanes.
- 9 HEATS** Heat sheets will be available on the day in Meet Mobile. Hard copies of heat sheets will be distributed on the day.
- 10 RESULTS** Results will be decided on heat times, there will be no finals. Results will be available on meet mobile. Results will be circulate to all entrants after the meet.

- 11 AWARDS** Medals will be awarded to individuals and teams placed 1st, 2nd, & 3rd in each age group. Where medals are not collected they will be used in future competitions to help keep the entry fees as low as possible.
- 12 TROPHIES** The Hampshire Masters Cup will be awarded to the club which accumulates the most points. 1st, 2nd & 3rd placing will get 3, 2 & 1 points respectively, with the exception of 25m events which are non-scoring. Teams get double points with the winners of each Team event awarded the Swim England 150yrs Anniversary Shields (x6). There are awards for the woman and the man gaining the most individual points provided that there is a minimum of 3 entrants in the age group.
- 13 CONDITIONS** The Promoter reserves the right to amend any of the conditions in this document to ensure the smooth running of the meet. The promoter will not be responsible for loss or damage to property occurring during the meet.

NOTES

1. Select your events so that you will have sufficient recovery time between swims.
2. Your email address. Automatic acknowledgement of entries will be by email. Additional information about the meet and any queries with your entry will also be sent by email.
